Discussion on current expenditures and the status of proposed future capital improvement projects – Jessica Gillesipe provided a detailed update on the proposed improvement projects at the High school and elementary school, including status, budget, and schedules. The initial projects identified in January 2020 were later augmented with additional items. However, the main areas are:
  - a. photovoltaic system, HVAC system upgrades
  - b. Fencing and overall safety
  - c. Library and classroom modernization (HS)
  - d. Children drop-off and parking areas (elementary)

Architectural and graphical representations of each area were reviewed with the committee members.

The total project cost and the variance (from original budget of the Bond) were submitted and discussed. (see below) Fig 1

Jessica reviewed all the expenditures to date and who was paid. The BOC verified that all the payees were appropriate.

The next steps are the finalization of the design, start of the bidding process. The schedule is expected to be approximately 12 months after the end of the bidding process
